Position Summary: The Education Intern will interact with children and adults in a variety of engaging activities and assist the efforts of the Education department through planning, facilitating, and evaluating various programs.

Essential Functions:

- Assist with family exhibitions, including the planning of future exhibitions.
- Assist with creating interpretive materials.
- Assist with program evaluation by conducting surveys.
