

OUR RULES

- Do not enter expansion areas—follow pedestrian traffic signs.
- Stay on pathways and mowed lawn areas.
- Do not touch sculptures. (Light touching is allowed for these two sculptures only: *The American Horse* and *Fred and Lena Meijer*.)
- Do not climb any sculptures, trees, walls, fountains, rocks or waterfalls.
- Do not wade or swim in ponds or streams.
- Supervise children at all times.
- Picnicking is allowed only in designated areas.
- Food and drinks are not allowed in any of our galleries or gift shop. No outside food or drink may be brought into the café.
- Due to Michigan state law, no alcohol may be brought onto the grounds or facilities, and will be confiscated. Violators may be asked to leave the premises.

- Pets are not allowed. Trained service animals are welcome.
- Do not feed or handle wildlife.
- No bicycling, rollerblading, jogging, skiing, etc.
- Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times.
- Smoking, e-cigarettes or similar devices are not permitted—we are a smoke-free environment.
