

# DIRECTIONS

1. This side up. Fold bottom right corner to top left corner, crease firmly. Unfold.
2. Fold bottom left corner to top right corner, crease firmly. Unfold.
3. Fold each corner point into the center. Leave folded.

4. Now flip over.
5. Fold all four corners into the center to make a square.
6. Now fold left to right side, then unfold and fold bottom to top and unfold.
7. You're ready to play & learn!
